Fr. Molini's Notes

Third Sunday of Advent

The prophet Žephaniah offers this prophecy in our first reading: "The Lord, your God, is in your midst, a mighty savior; he will rejoice over you with gladness and renew you in his love..." The prophet sees the presence of God among his people, not with fear and retribution, but with joy and renewal. John the Baptist reiterates this in his call to responsible discipleship. Our daily lives must reflect the faith we profess, as demonstrated in our charity toward others and in our humility as children of God. John even distinguishes his prophecy as apart from that of "...one mightier than I..." In the power of his preaching, John holds nothing for himself, always directing attention to Jesus.

What a beautiful message for Advent, and the joy that is assured those who live in expectation of Christ's coming. How do we show our joy in the works of charity, the humility of forgiveness, the devotion to prayerfulness, the participation in community? Our Savior came to bind us together as a body, THE Body of Christ. How do we foster that unity in peace? The prophets call us to renewal. It begins with our recognition of the need to be renewed, and then the confidence to rely upon the One who will "...gather the wheat into his barn...:" accepting the Good News he shares.
