Fr. Molini's Notes

Baptism of the Lord

This feast offers us a transition from the private life of Jesus to his public life and proclamation of the Good News. In His baptism, we benefit because, as He descends into the water, He embraces all the sins of the world; and, in rising from the water, He opens for us the heavenly realm, offering the grace of the Holy Spirit. Three occasions in our lives offer an assurance of His gift of redemption: our baptism, Holy Mass, and our death. Dr. Pius Parsch, a liturgical authority describes it as such: "At my baptism I was immersed with Christ, and with Him I died and was buried. Then I emerged, and for the first time, heaven opened to me as the Holy Spirit made His entrance into my soul; and my Father in heaven glanced down upon me, now His son, His daughter, His child. In each holy Mass Christ's baptism is again operative. Through the holy Sacrifice I am immersed in His sacrificial death; heaven then opens and the Holy Spirit descends in holy Communion while, through the pledge of the sacrificial Banquet, the Father assures me of renewed and enriched kinship in Himself. The baptism of Christ takes place within me a third time at death, for death is indeed a sort of baptism. Death is like immersion into the dark depths, and, when I emerge, it is into heaven above. Then I will see the Blessed Trinity, no longer through the darkened sunglass of faith, but in immediate vision, face to face." (The Church's Year of Grace, Vol. 1)

In all this, the death of Christ is the foundation of the spiritual life. Through Baptism and the Eucharist, we build on the foundation of Christ, while the Lord's return at death completes the work of redemption, lifting us to heaven. The Baptism of the Lord helps foreshadow this promise of grace and prepares us to enter into His public life sharing the Good News.

Footsteps of St. Paul

In the past I have participated in a number of pilgrimages, serving as the priest for the journey. In cooperation with Taveltyme, a local travel agency, a trip has been prepared for this summer to Greece and to the area visiting sites associated with St. Paul. St. Vincent de Paul

For most of us, Christmas is over until next December. We have taken down the wreaths and stored away the ornaments. But, for some of our neighbors in need, this Christmas may have an everlasting impact. Perhaps we gave a child a Christmas tree with ornaments or a doll to hold in her arms. Maybe we gave an adult a warm pair of gloves or hand lotion to soothe blistered hands. These acts most likely brought tears to our neighbors' eyes, as they realize that someone cared. These gifts of kindness go a long way to help them put one foot in front of the other while they climb out of poverty. Your prayers and donations make all this possible. Thank you.

"John answered them all, 'I baptize you with water; but he who is mightier than I is coming...he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit...'" Luke 3:16

The Catholic Catechism states that "Jesus' immersion in the water is a sign for all human beings of the need to die to themselves to do God's will." In other words, as baptized Catholics there is only one gift that we need to give to Jesus – the gift of ourselves. Let us surrender ourselves to God, place our trust in Him and allow the Holy Spirit to work through us for the greater glory of God.






