Care for the Missions

From our earliest days as a community of faith, assistance has been shared with others, extending the mercy of God to all.

Enlightening

Mass Intentions

A centuries-old practice in the Catholic Church, offering Mass for a specific intention, heightens the awareness of praying for others. While every Mass is offered for the good of the Church in praise of the Father through the Sacrifice of Jesus Christ, the custom of asking for a particular remembrance during each Mass allows us to support each other in prayer. The practice of making an offering for the intention also unites the sacrifice of the faithful to the sacrifice of Christ. While the "stipend" is not required for a Mass, it is customarily made as a gift to the priest celebrating the Mass. Masses offered for the deceased for the repose of their souls will have their names mentioned in the bulletin. A Mass for the living is usually shown simply as a "special intention" for privacy purposes; however, the person's name can be included, if so desired.

Mass intentions may be sent to the parish office. The customary stipend of \$10 is appreciated but not required. Specific dates for a Mass can often be accommodated.

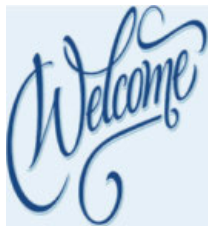

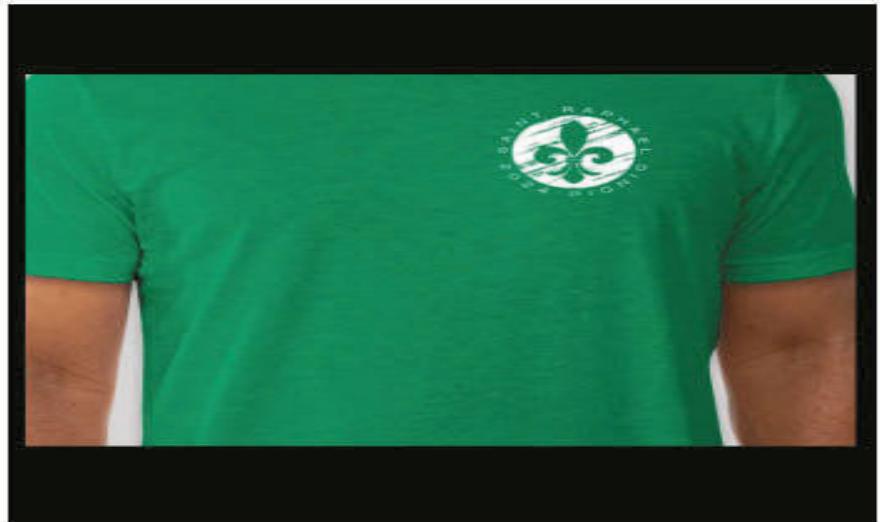

June Is Gun Violence Awareness Month

Gun violence devastates individuals, families, and communities in the United States and the St. Louis Archdiocese. As Archbishop Rozanski noted at last summer’s Gun Violence Summit, “Gun violence is a human life -- a quality of life -- issue. Those who are threatened by gun violence are not living the fullest potential of their lives.” In Missouri, more than 1,300 people die by guns every year, the 7th highest rate of gun deaths in the country.

This is Wear Orange Weekend that is a movement to honor victims and survivors of gun violence and to raise awareness of the impact of gun violence; orange is the color hunters wear in the woods to protect themselves and others. As we hear in today’s Gospel, “...if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand.” So, instead, let us stand together in solidarity this weekend with any American who wears orange in tribute to the more than 43,000 Americans killed with guns and the 76,000 more who are shot and wounded each year.

I am Sr. Pelagia Karengi. I am a member of the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary - Tabora in Tanzania. I was born in Manyara Region, in Northern Tanzania. In 1991, I joined my community of the Daughters of Mary in Western Tanzania, in the Tabora Region. I made my first vow in 1996 and my final vow in 2002. I graduated with an Associate Degree in Liberal arts from Assumption College for Sisters in New Jersey in 2015. I received a Bachelor’s Degree in Arts from Georgian Court University in New Jersey in 2017. I moved to Omaha, Nebraska, in August 2017, and I am pursuing a Master’s Degree at Creighton University. My goal is to become a certified teacher. In addition to my studies, I reside at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish where I volunteer in the parish and school.

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to share with you about the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary-Tabora and our needs in Tanzania.

The Congregation of the Daughters of Mary-Tabora (CDMT)

The Congregation of the Daughters of Mary, headquartered in the Archdiocese of Tabora, was founded in 1933. It was established in response to the tremendous social, economic, and spiritual needs of the local people. Our Community members live their Charisma of love and service through different ministries, such as health care, pastoral ministry, social works, education, and women and youth development. Education and healthcare services are particularly directed to rural areas where we serve nomadic people, orphans, and deaf children.

Retirement Home for Elderly and Infirm Sisters

Due to insufficient space in our current building, we have started to build a decent home with facilities and space to render good service to our elderly and infirm sisters. We need \$500,000 to complete the construction of a new building. We aim to implement this project in five years, 2023 -2027. However, the urgent need is to purchase items to immediately help our elderly and bedridden sisters.

Special walk-in showers	\$ 1,500 each

Without proper equipment and facilities, it is almost impossible to move or bathe our sisters who are weak or in wheelchairs. Your financial support is highly appreciated and will always be put to good use to enable us to effectively meet the needs of our elderly and infirm sisters.

As St. John Paul II said, *some become missionaries by going to the missions; others go by giving to the missions; without both, there are no missions.* I invite you to be partners in the work of the Daughters of Mary, to make a difference in the lives of the elderly sisters who have made a difference in the lives of the suffering poor in Tanzania. Thank you for your support and prayers.

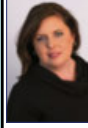

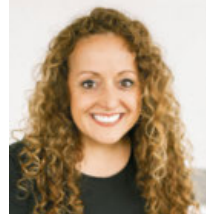
