#### **Advent Approaches**

Beginning on December 1, the season of Advent opens the new liturgical year and directs our attention to the preparations for Christmas. While so many of us will make special efforts to decorate our homes for Christmas, how are we preparing our souls for the celebration of Christ's birth? The second graders remind us of a wonderful way to prepare as they make their way to their First Reconciliation during Advent. #### Statement of the Missouri Catholic Conference on Acceptance of Amendment 3 (Constitutional Right to Abortion)

We are grateful to the Catholic faithful, clergy, and all people of good will who worked tirelessly during this campaign to uphold the dignity of life and defend our state's most vulnerable. They, along with us, remain committed to uphold and proclaim the inherent dignity of all. Let us continue to pray and work for a greater recognition of the gift of each and every human life in our society.


#### **Early Bulletin Deadlines**
